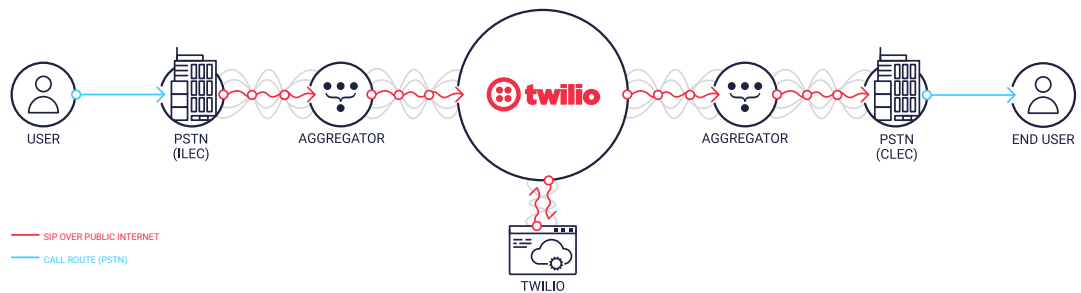
# The Carrier Advantage

Telnyx is a full-fledged carrier that controls the entire telephony stack, down to the global, private IP network on which we built our service. Instead of relying on telecom aggregators and resellers, our APIs directly control our own infrastructure, providing a higher quality experience at a lower cost.

# Numbers & Porting

## Owned Numbers and a Faster Porting Experience

As a licensed carrier, Telnyx maintains complete control over a database of local and toll-free phone numbers across the globe, passing that control and configuration to you in a self-service, API-first product.

Twilio, on the other hand, does not own their own number inventory, instead relying on third-party providers for phone numbers.

Telnyx also streamlines the porting for customers looking to bring over phone numbers from a previous provider. Telnyx FastPort® automates the porting process to make it faster and more transparent compared to competitors like Twilio. CSR validation happens in real time, identifying and correcting account errors before the port request is submitted. This reduces porting time by days or even weeks while giving you peace of mind that your port will be accepted and on time.

And with our self-service options in the Telnyx Mission Control Portal, you can track the progress of your porting request from start to finish.

Because Twilio depends on other carriers to handle porting requests, there is less visibility throughout the process as well as increased wait times.





# Real-Time Communications

## The Benefits of Media Streaming

Unlike TwiML, which pulls a pre-scripted call workflow at the beginning of the call, Telnyx Programmatic Call Control operates in real time.

Telnyx exchanges commands and webhooks with your application's system as the call progresses. So, instead of requiring all intended commands at the start of the call, you can receive input throughout the conversation for a truly dynamic experience.

**Collect and review call analytics mid-conversation to gain valuable caller insights.** Telnyx workflows evolve based on the actions taken during the call, and direct real-time control can be extended to end users through an application's graphical user interface (GUI).



For example, contact centers may use sentiment analysis to influence call routes, matching the caller to the right agent based on their mood or profile.

This level of real-time decision making and control just isn't possible with Twilio.





# APIs

## JSON vs. TwiML

Telnyx uses JSON-based APIs, a favorite format for developers because of its ease of use and readability. Twilio's API is written in a proprietary XML-like language, which is less efficient and hides structure from the developers.

Because the Telnyx API is entirely JSON-based, it's easy to map requests, responses and webhooks to objects in your domain. Additionally, you can easily compose complex workflows, utilizing call control commands and requests across the rest of our API without changing contexts.

If you're comfortable working with JSON and HTTP, you're ready to take full advantage of the Telnyx APIs.







# Support

## Stop Paying for Customer Service

We understand that customers will have questions, and we don't think you should have to pay for support. That's why we **offer free 24/7/365 support to our customers**, with engineers available around the clock for help and troubleshooting.

Though Twilio does offer a variety of support plans, they're not without limitations and added costs. Their free plan offers email support during business hours only, but **Twilio customers must pay upwards of \$18,000 a year if they want phone support and 24/7 coverage.**

## Non-Carrier

Twilio relies on the public internet for connectivity and middlemen for call routing and core communications functionality.

## Expensive Voice

Twilio voice starts at \$0.007/min for outbound and \$0.0045/min for inbound calls.

## Pay for Inbound

Twilio charges \$0.0075 to both send and receive SMS. If you're looking to leverage conversational messaging, costs can quickly escalate.

## Partners With Aggregators

Twilio relies on middlemen to supply numbers, resulting in higher markups and less flexibility.

## Scripted Communications

Twiml requires pre-scripted workflows at the start of the call, meaning real-time decision making and control just aren't possible.

## Restrictive APIs

Twilio's API is written in a proprietary XML-like language. XML APIs are less efficient as they hide structure from developers.

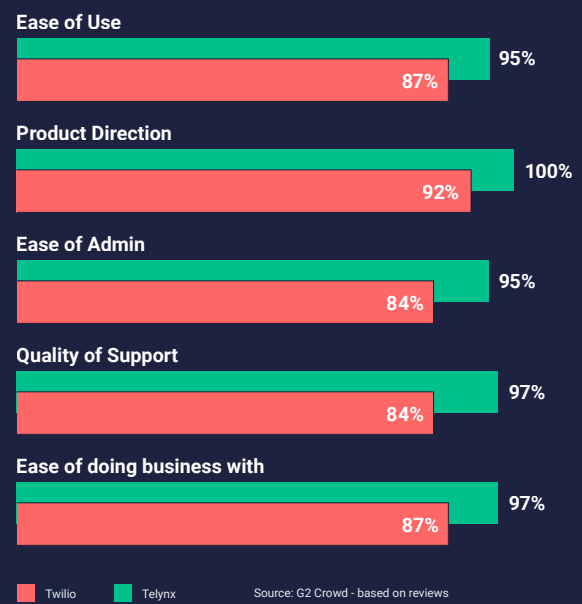
